YEAR 10: TRIAL EXAMS

Dear Parents,

I am writing to inform you that your child will be completing trial examinations from the week beginning 10th June 2019 and across the following three-week period.

In order to prepare students effectively for their GCSEs next summer, they will complete exams in core subjects in the Sports Hall during the Y11 GCSE public examination period and when not in exams students will be in normal lessons. (Please see the timetable on the reverse of this letter).

The trial exams are an opportunity for students to further experience what it's like to sit exams in an exam environment, which they will do so in a year's time, and will enable them to get vital feedback from their subject teachers to help them move forward in their learning.

On the reverse of this letter is the year 10 exam timetable. Please go through this with your child to ensure they know what exams they have and when they are taking place. It is imperative your child prepares fully for these exams so that they can identify areas where they are doing well and areas where there are gaps in their learning.
